Dimensions and Tolerances

All dimensions are shown in inches unless otherwise noted. Tolerances are generally held to ± 0.015 " for fractions and ± 0.005 " on 3-place decimals. Any divergences from these tolerances will be indicated on a part-by-part basis.

With plastic moulding, there are always small amounts of flash, knockout pin marks, gates and other slight imperfections that may cause a minor

deviation from published tolerances. Please feel free to request a sample for your evaluation.

Note: Parts may not be exactly as shown.

Colour

The majority of the items shown in this catalogue are made of natural nylon (cream to white). Special colours and alternate materials are indicated on a

part-by-part basis.

Most nylon parts can be dyed to other colours, but exact colour matches cannot be made, and variations in shading can occur. For invoices under \$100.00, dyeing is \$20.00. For invoices over \$100.00, add 20% to unit price of each item to be dyed.
